POSITION SUMMARY

The Head Mechanist is responsible for the safe, efficient, and high-quality delivery of all scenic elements of productions. This role leads the mechanist team and oversees the installation, operation, and maintenance of sets, while ensuring full compliance with safety standards. The Head Mechanist works closely with the creative team to ensure the artistic vision is realised effectively and safely.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Leadership & Supervision

- Lead, supervise, and mentor the mechanist team, including scheduling and task allocation
- Ensure all crew are trained and competent in mechanical systems and safe work practices
- Act as the primary point of contact for all mechanist-related matters

Mechanical Operations

- In collaboration with Production Managers assist with cost out of new productions scenic designs
- As required by designers, plan build schedules and or Bid Documents
- Oversee the installation, operation and maintenance of all scenic elements.
- Ensure smooth execution of scene changes, automation cues, and mechanical effects during rehearsals and performances
- Troubleshoot and resolve issues promptly and safely

Safety & Compliance

- Ensure all mechanical systems comply with relevant safety regulations, standards, and codes of practice.
- Assist with risk assessments, inspections, and toolbox talks.
- Maintain documentation including maintenance logs, safety checks, and incident reports.

Planning & Coordination

- Collaborate with directors, designers, stage managers, and production managers to realise creative visions within budgetary constraints.
- Contribute to production planning, bump-in/bump-out schedules, and technical rehearsals.
- Manage mechanical requirements for touring productions, including transport and venue adaptation.
